According to the Florida Standard Charter Contract, which must serve as the base of negotiations for all charter agreements in the State of Florida, "The sponsor shall annually evaluate the School on its performance and progress toward meeting the standards and targets included in this contract, including academic achievement goals. If the term of this contract exceeds five years, the Sponsor shall conduct a High-Stakes Review at least every five years and shall present the findings of the review to the governing board of the School.'

This purpose also is aligned with the Florida Principles & Standards for Quality Charter School Authorizing, drafted by the Department in collaboration with national experts and authorizers across Florida. The Principles & Standards provides that charter sponsors "grant initial charter contracts for a term of five years or longer only with periodic high-stakes reviews every five years or more frequently ..."
